Instructions to Schools

- 2. Substitution for any of the specimens listed below is normally not allowed. Prior permission must be sought from the Council for any change that might be absolutely necessary.

3. (a) Each candidate should be provided with the following specimens labelled with the letters in **bold** type:

A: Drenching gun;

B: Feathers;

C: Carpet grass;

D: Leaves of cassava with mosaic disease;

E: Small radio;

F: Urea (labelled);

G: Cassava stem (cutting);

H: Sprinkler head;

J: Spade;

K: Mattock;

L: Hand trowel.

(b) Where the specimen is **not** available in sufficient quantities, it should be shared between small groups of candidates.

- Supervisor's Report Forms will be provided separately, on which you will be required to:
 - supply details of any substitution of specimens or materials made;
 - (b) report on any particular difficulties experienced by any candidate, especially if the Examiner would be unable to discover those difficulties from the scripts.
- You must enclose a completed Report Form in each envelope of scripts.
