Instructions to Schools

- Substitution for any of the specimens listed overleaf is usually not allowed. Prior permission must be sought from the Council for any change that might be absolutely necessary.

(b) (i) Where a specimen is **not** readily available in sufficient quantity, it should be shared between small groups of candidates.

(ii) Each candidate should be provided with the following specimens labelled accordingly:

A: Ginger;

B: Spear grass (whole plant);

C: Sprinkler head;

D: Cassava stem cutting;

E: Farmyard manure;

F: Black polythene polypot;

G: Pride of Barbados (Branch with

flowers);

H: Yam tuber.

- 4. Supervisor's Report Forms will be provided separately on which you will be required to:
 - (a) supply details of the specimens and materials provided;
 - (b) supply details of any substitutions made;
 - (c) report on any particular difficulties experienced by any candidate, especially if the examiner would be unable to discover those difficulties from the scripts;
 - (c) Make and record experimental observations.
